

### Communication and Language

Talk about our experiences during holidays. Talk about the focus stories and reinforce key vocabulary. Describe characters and settings from fairy tales. Talk about our favourite parts of the stories and why. Concentrate on using full sentences when speaking.

### Physical development

We will control our body to push, pat, throw, catch or kick things like a large ball, a balloon or piece of fabric.

We will focus on correct letter formation and starting and finishing letters in the correct place.

### Mathematics

We will continue to secure our knowledge of numbers to 10 and beyond. We will be counting groups of objects and beginning to use the language of more, fewer and altogether. We will use counting to help us to find out problems that are important to us. We will continue our work on shape and order items by length, height and weight.

### Understanding of the world

What kind of changes can happen, could happen or have happened.

Explore animals and settings in stories we read; Compare to what we know and our surroundings. Take pictures of different surroundings.

### Literacy

In phonics we will be learning new sounds in phase 3 and begin blending to read and segmenting to spell with these new sounds. We will continue working on forming letters correctly and learning the names of letters. We will be reading a selection of fairy tales.

### Expressive arts and design

We will be acting out lots of different fairy tales and exploring characters thoughts and feelings. Paint pictures of favourite fairy tale characters and add details and texture using collage.

Construct and make models of own interest and related to our theme.

### Personal, social and emotional development

We will explore faces and body language expressing different feelings and talk about what they represent.

We will be confident to say when we do or do not need help.
