

### English

In English, we will be looking at the book *Croc and Bird* by Alexis Deacon and as we read it we will be exploring and responding to the illustrations leading to creating our own picture books and information pages.

### Computing

In computing, we will be looking at the skills of word processing. This will include copy and pasting images, changing the size and type of font and formatting information on a word document.

### Maths

In Maths, we will be focusing on our place value skills so we can recognise the value of digits in numbers, order and compare numbers up to 1000 and solve problems using our skills. We will also add and subtract 3 digit numbers together.

### History/Geography

In Geography we will discuss the early life of birds and crocodiles investigating their habitats and how they are different to our own and why they are different.

### PSHE

In PSHE, our focus is speaking and listening and through group and pair work we will discuss what makes us unique.

### Religious Education

In R.E, the focus this half term is Islam and we will particularly focus on learning about some of the key leaders of the faith.

### Science

In Science, we will be learning about the human body, focussing on the role of the skeleton, how muscles help us move and what nutrients we need to eat.

### Design Technology/Art

In Art we will be look at the artist *Claude Monet* and how he used water colours to create beautiful art. We will then have a go at creating our own.

### Physical Education

In PE, we will be developing our catching and throwing skills as well as learning how to dribble as we learn how to play basketball. We will also be swimming.

### Music

In music, we will be starting to learn how to play the recorder. We will be focusing on learning how to play notes and read music.

### Languages

In Languages, we will be learning French. We will be learning some simple phrases so we can have a conversation with each other.
