COVID-19 UPDATE

Altogether there have now been seven positive covid-19 cases connected to school: four cases in the Y5 bubble – two pupils and two staff; one case in the Y3 bubble – one pupil; one case with one member of kitchen staff; one pupil case in Year 2. All these pupils and staff are fine.
 The home page on the school website <u>www.west-street.org</u> contains information for Year 2 and Year 3 parents about self-isolation and information for the parents of all other year groups who are not self-isolating at the moment.

In order to monitor any further covid-19 cases related to school during half-term, we have set up a specific email <u>covid@weststreet.lancs.sch.uk</u> We are asking parents and staff to contact us on this email address when they or a member of their household has had a covid-19 test, then to report the test results. This information will only be shared with Miss. Watson and Mrs. Duerden. It will help us to make sure all is safe for year groups to return to school on Monday 2nd November.

All parents will receive a text on Sunday 1st November to confirm that school will be open to all pupils except Year 2.

Year 2 will return to school on Wednesday 4th November following the end of their self-isolation period.

Thank you so much for your on-going communication and support – this is very much appreciated as it keeps us informed and therefore able to make the best decisions for the children in our care.
