We will also be inviting children to "bring a friend to lunch". Please see additional sheet.

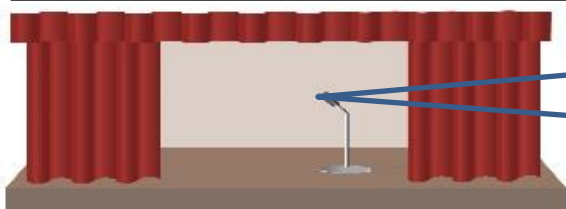
Children in Need next Friday 16th
