

Dear Nursery and Reception Parents,

There has been a positive Covid-19 test within your child's bubble (Nursery and Reception).

This means that Nursery and Reception will need to be closed from Monday 22nd March until Saturday 27th March whilst the children and staff in this bubble self-isolate. Sunday 28th March will be the first day out of self-isolation. Nursery and Reception's return to school date will be Monday 12th April after the Easter holidays.

Other family members within the household do not need to self-isolate **UNLESS** anybody they live with displays symptoms or has a positive test result.

Siblings of Nursery and Reception children do not need to self-isolate and should still come to school unless someone they live with develops symptoms.

School will be deep cleaned.
